EXHIBIT "A"

1. With regard to the following specific pole locations, PETITIONER agrees as follows:
 - a. Node pole 2d-8b - On Somerville Ave at Craigie Street. To conform to new lighting as part of the Somerville Ave renovation project, Petitioner will purchase and install a "Washington Post" style pole and light. This is a new pole installation -- it will not be a replacement. Petitioner agrees that it shall own and maintain the pole and the light fixture, and the City will maintain, repair and replace the light bulb as necessary. Petitioner will pay all costs for power to the light. Petitioner shall install banner brackets at the direction of the City at the time of the pole installation.
 - b. Node pole 2d-14 - Directly in front of Citizens Bank on Bow Street and Warren Street. Same arrangement as 1(a) above. This new pole will be installed next to an existing streetlight. Once the Petitioner completes installation of the new pole, the City may elect to inform the Petitioner to seek approval from the pole owner, NStar, to remove the existing concrete pole. Petitioner shall restore the sidewalk once the old pole is removed.
 - c. Node pole 2d-20b - Intersection of Pearl & Cross Streets. Petitioner agrees to purchase and install a new steel pole matching the style of the existing concrete poles in the area, with a single cobra head streetlight fixture. It will be mounted next to the existing traffic signal pole. Petitioner will own and maintain the new pole. City will maintain, repair, and replace the light bulb as necessary. Petitioner shall pay all costs of power to the light.
 - d. Node Pole 2d-19 - Intersection of Pearl & Medford Streets. Petitioner agrees to purchase and install a new steel pole matching the style of the existing NStar concrete pole with a double cobra head light fixture. Petitioner agrees that it shall own and maintain the pole and the light fixture, and the City will maintain, repair and replace the light bulbs as necessary. Petitioner will pay all costs for power to the lights. Once the Petitioner completes installation of the new pole, the City may elect to inform the Petitioner to seek approval from the pole owner, NStar, to remove the existing concrete pole. Petitioner shall restore the sidewalk once the old pole is removed.
2. Petitioner agrees that any material deviations to NextG's Equipment under the petition shall be subject to review by the City's DPW Commissioner and may require additional approval by the City;

3. Petitioner shall remove all NextG Equipment from any poles being replaced within thirty (30) days of the date written notice is received by NextG that replacement poles are being erected for the pole upon which NextG Equipment is installed;
4. In the event Petitioner is notified of a need in any of the twenty-nine (29) locations for public safety apparatus, the Petitioner agrees to provide the fibers along said locations to provide connectivity for the City's exclusive use for public safety purposes;
5. Petitioner shall not be permitted to install equipment/utility boxes in any locations other than the twenty-nine (29) locations specifically identified in its petition;
6.
