#### **AirBnB**

- **2. 202776: Discuss** (Connolly, and the Entire Board) That the Superintendent of Inspectional Services, with the assistance of other departments as necessary, forward to this Board's Committee on Public Health and Safety a list of AirBnB-type lodging facilities in the city.
- **3. 202801: Discuss** (Davis, Rossetti, and the Entire Board) That the Administration advise this Board on the proposed state regulation of AirBnB properties, and options the city might have for taxation and regulation.
