1. **Approval of the March 15, 2022 Minutes**
2. **213074: Discuss** (BurnleyJr., Kelly) – That the City Solicitor draft language to amend the Housing Stability Notification Act to proactively meet the needs of residents.
3. **213186: Discuss** (BurnleyJr.) – That the City Solicitor advise this Council on its ability to ban quotas in law enforcement, including the application for grants that require additional enforcement as a prerequisite.
