## Dear City of Somerville,

#### PROJECT BRIEF

The birdhouse project is a chance to give people of all ages a great winter project and draw some attention to our environment as well as sustainable housing. We're hoping to get schools and a lot of the community involved. It's a chance for Somerville to be creative and show it's design-chops in a real-world art gallery / home.

The community will create birdhouses that we will place in trees in Somerville. We need the permissions to place birdhouses in trees in the following areas.

#### **PROJECT DATES**

The project will be announced as soon as we have secured permissions for people to begin building.

### Installation: 4.12.2014

We hope the birdhouses will become an artistic fixture in the neighborhoods and last for years. To this end, we will use galvanized wire and wrap around the trees (no screws) to secure houses to trees. We will take precautions to ensure that the birdhouses are mounted safely in trees and that the trees themselves are protected as well as those who walk below them.

In the case that a birdhouse is not suitable or becomes unfit, we will remove the birdhouse.

The number of houses we will have in this first year is highly variable. Fortunately, the project is easily scalable as long as we can get location permits. Also, numerous birdhouses can fit in trees, while still providing excellent housing for birds and visibility for the project.

#### LOCATIONS:

Locations are listed in order of preference. We are flexible and willing to work with other locations as well.



Location 1 is a stand of trees on either side of the community path. This location can host up to 30 birdhouses.

Location 2 is in the center of Davis square. This can host up to 20 birdhouses.

Should we need more space than this, which is unlikely in our first year, we'd like to put birdhouses in union square center or continue along the community bike path that runs to alewife.
