This is a disservice to the residents.

The bus stop in its original location had worked well for bus riders ever since buses began running on Beacon Street. Residents – in particular our disabled neighbors – relied on the parking spaces. It all worked. By contrast, the new bus stop has already encouraged multiple parking infractions, and has made life more difficult for residents.
