1. Approval of the April 14, 2021 Minutes

- **2. 210380: Discuss** (Strezo) That the Directors of SPCD, Housing Stability, and Inspectional Services discuss with the Housing and Community Development Committee the anticipated impact and possible responses when the MA Eviction Moratorium expires on August 18.
- **3. 211346: Discuss** (Ewen-Campen, Mbah, Scott, Ballantyne, Davis, Strezo) That the Committee on Housing and Community Development convene housing advocates and staff to address racial disparities in home mortgages, including programs like Boston's One+ program to increase assistance for first-time and low-income home buyers.
- **4. 205286: Discuss** (Hirsch, and the Entire Board) That the Director of SPCD share what role the city has, or could have with additional staff, in assisting residents with condo association dilemmas, tenant organizing, or ensuring that inclusionary unit owners or

tenants have equal voice in building decisions.

- **5. 209361: Discuss** (Ballantyne, McLaughlin) That the Director of SPCD discuss the impact on small businesses city-wide since the expansion and growth of Assembly Square and the opening of the Encore Casino.
