City of Somerville: Public Safety Support for Bridge Closures

Dear Mayor Curtatone:

The MBTA recognizes that the closures of the School Street Bridge, Medford Street Bridge, Broadway Bridge and the Washington Street Railroad Bridge underpass will require the City of Somerville to provide additional public safety support. The MBTA agrees to support the City of Somerville for emergency and first responder services, including equipment and apparatus, which are directly related to these extensive bridge closures for the amount of \$325,000.00.

Please ensure payment of these expenses is clearly delineated and tracked. As you are aware, The Green Line Extension Project receives funding from the U.S. Federal Transit Administration ("FTA"); therefore, MBTA is using in part, FTA funds to reimburse the City of Somerville. As the MBTA is subject to FTA audits, the City of Somerville may be subject to future auditing by the FTA to ensure all funds are properly expended on Green Line Extension Project matters associated with first responders involved with support of these extensive bridge closures.

Please sign and return this letter, acknowledging you have been advised of the terms for reimbursement, along with an invoice to facilitate this transaction.
