Chairman O'Donovan recused himself from discussion on matters pertaining to Granite Street, since an attorney in his office has been contacted about the issue.

Alderman Desmond reported that the residents on Granite Street who are involved with the utility pole matter have hired an attorney. The Clerk of Committees forwarded a copy of an email from Tim Kelly, the Community Relations representative from Comcast, stating that he couldn't disclose the details of the situation other than to say that the involved parties are still at the table and that the issue is very unique and complicated.

- \* Mr. Koty reported that progress is being made on the double poles at
