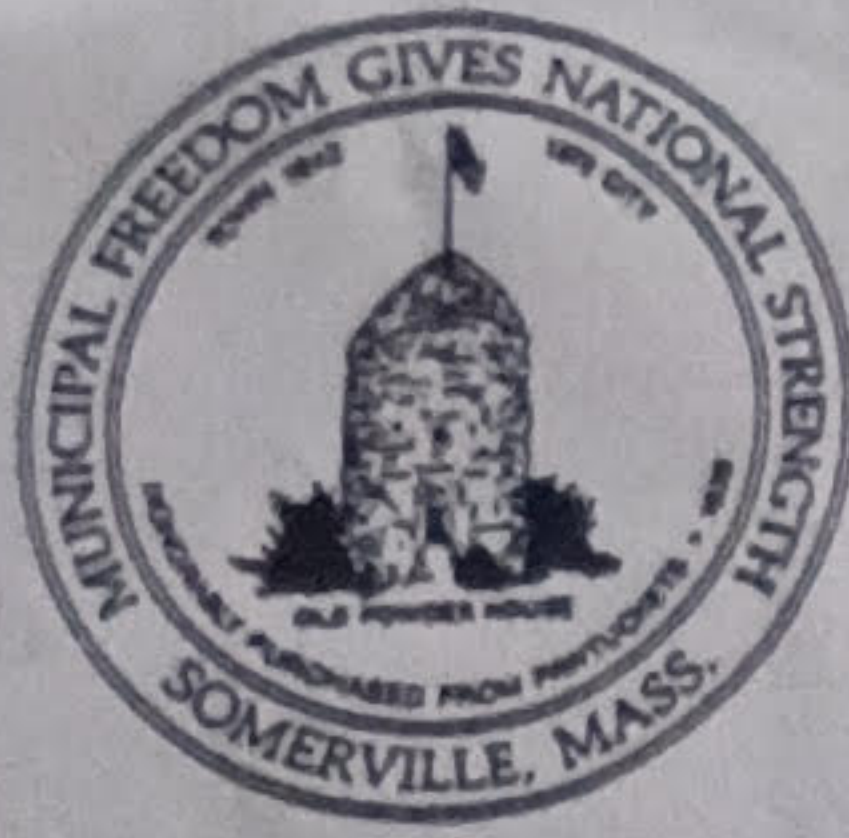

This meeting of the City Council will be conducted in person and by remote participation, using the Zoom platform.

PETITION: Eversource is applying for a Grant of Location to install approximately a total of 48 feet of conduit in Vernon Street, from Utility Pole 152/9 to an approximate point of pickup at 70 Vernon Street.

TIME: Thursday, November 25, 2025, at 7:00 PM.

PURPOSE: This work is necessary to provide electric service to #70 Vernon Street.
