For the past five years, Starlab Studios has organized the **Starlabfest Music & Arts Festival**, an event dedicated to showcasing the vibrant and eclectic creative culture in Somerville and the Boston area. We feature work from local artists and filmmakers and performances from the area's most exciting local bands.

Now in our sixth year of producing the festival, we have watched it continue to grow in both scale and attendance, due in part to regular features in the **Boston Globe**, the **Boston Metro** and countless online press outlets. Last year, we were nominated for "Best Music Festival" by **BDCWire** (boston.com).

The Somerville Arts Council has been generous enough to offer use of the property at 10 Poplar St. for this years festival, pictured below.

The crowd at Starlabfest tends to **range in age from ~23-40**, leaning heavily towards mid to late 20 somethings. The cultural demographic is mostly made up of the **creative**, **hip and socially active**, as well as young families and neighborhood folks. Based on attendance in previous years, we expect **300-500 concertgoers** throughout the day, ~150-250 at peak times.
