Resolution

Daniel Faber, PhD. and Eric Krieg, PhD., identify Chelsea as the 3rd most intensively Whereas, overburdened community in Massachusetts;1 and The Massachusetts Executive Office of Environmental Affairs (EOEEA) Environmental Whereas, Justice Policy classifies every single neighborhood in Chelsea as an environmental justice population;2 and Chelsea is one of the most densely populated cities/towns in state with more than 35,000 Whereas, residents inhabiting 1.8 square miles; and Global Oil located in Revere, MA is proposing to bring freight trains carrying ethanol to Whereas, their facilities along the Chelsea River via the commuter rail line; and Ethanol is an alcohol based fuel that is mixed with gasoline and is a highly volatile, Whereas, flammable, colorless liquid that burns at extremely high temperatures; and Large volumes of alcohol resistant foam are necessary to extinguish ethanol fires; and Whereas, Global Oil is proposing to bring 60-car trains, each car carrying 30,000 gallons of ethanol, Whereas, into its facility twice per week, every week. This will result in 187,200,000 gallons of ethanol on freight trains coming through our neighborhoods each year; and The train will travel through other densely populated communities including Boston, Whereas, Cambridge, Somerville, Everett and Revere; and The train travels very closely to the Williams School, the Mary C. Burke Elementary School Whereas, Complex and Chelsea High School in addition to the urban renewal district, MGH and the MITC Building; and Should a fire or explosion occur, thousands of people and dozens of businesses can be Whereas,

impacted -- entire neighborhoods decimated; and
