3. **208668: Discuss** (White Jr., Mbah, Hirsch, McLaughlin, Rossetti, Niedergang, Ballantyne, Clingan, Scott, Ewen-Campen) – That the Legislative Matters Committee prepare an ordinance to regulate the placement of wireless facilities to the maximum extent permitted by state law.
4. **(ID # 21672):** Assistant City Solicitor submitting an Ordinance to regulate Small Wireless Facilities in the Public Right of Way.
5. **(ID # 21701):** 2 residents submitting comments re: the deployment of 5G small wireless facilities.
6. **207364: Recommend** (Ewen-Campen, Niedergang, Mbah, Davis, Ballantyne, McLaughlin, Scott, Clingan, White Jr., Rossetti, Hirsch) – That would increase public oversight of surveillance technology, in order to balance public safety with the individual right to privacy.
7. **(ID # 21649):** (Ewen-Campen) – Proposing a revised amendment to the Municipal Ordinances to provide public oversight over the procurement and usage of surveillance technology, including a summary of the major revisions.
8. **208626: Recommend** Requesting approval of an Ordinance to be known as the Housing

Stability Notification Act.

9. **205918: Discuss** (McLaughlin, Davis, Ewen-Campen, and the Entire Board) – That the Administration submit a Home Rule Petition similar to Boston's "Jim Brooks Act," but with less rigid language, to encourage passage by the State.
