Now that the initial award has become final, it is time to see if we can agree on the remedy. The SMEA has determined as a factual matter that between February 2008 and the time that she was laid off, Ms. Pefine worked numerous times in an out-of-grade capacity for Ms. Pickett. It has calculated the out-of-grade pay to which she would have received as follows:

2008 - \$639.13 2009 - \$464.51 2010 - \$1,104.50

The total amount is \$2208.14. Our proposed remedy, therefore is that the City shall forthwith pay that amount to Ms. Pefine, less the appropriate deductions. Please let me know if that is acceptable or if the City has a different understanding as to the number of times that Ms. Pefine worked in this out-of-grade pay capacity.
