Hi Susan,

My name is Tom Pasquarello and I am the Chief of Police in Somerville. I believe we may have spoken once before. I approve the public event permits including all your previous requests for the vigil in Davis Square Plaza, Wednesday nights from 4pm-5:pm.

The week before last when I was driving through Davis Square I observed an individual affiliated with your group standing in the small island crosswalk, with a sign waving it at oncoming traffic, in such a way that it created a major distraction to vehicle traffic. I was concerned for two reasons. The small island is very narrow and only intended for pedestrians that may have only made it half way across the street before the light changes. The island can perhaps accommodate only a few pedestrians. In addition to being outside of the authorized location, the individual with the sign was waving it in such an aggressive fashion, it became readily apparent that drivers passing through this dangerous intersection were being distracted and not paying attention to the pedestrians crossing and the traffic signals. I explained my concern to your volunteers and they were understanding.

I wanted to reiterate that I approve the permit for Statue Park, not the crosswalk or other areas, and it would be greatly appreciated if the volunteers would keep their signs and banners in hand. I also received complaints that signs were left laying on the ground and/or attached to the statues. If you have any questions or require additional clarification please feel free to contact me. Thank you.
