Dear Mayor Curtatone and Staff:

I'm submitting my name for consideration to fill a vacancy on the Somerville Redevelopment Authority (SRA) Board. The SRA provides oversight and agency to implement the City's urban renewal plans. Given limited space, high residential density, continued housing demand, as well as goals for commercial development to deliver jobs and open space to improve quality of life, the SRA will be busy and face difficult decisions for many years to come.

The SRA will always benefit from members well versed in design and architecture, real estate development, and financial planning but today's effective urban development organizations also benefit from broad experience including governance, community engagement, strategic communication, and cross sector collaboration. The SRA is facing changing citizen expectations of transparency and trust. Regionally we've seen similar organizations undergo transformations to address such challenges. The Boston Redevelopment Authority has been recast as the Boston Planning and Development Agency following accusations of cronyism. The Cambridge Redevelopment Authority changed how it interacts with the community following an extensive strategic planning process. Historically redevelopment authorities were created to address deteriorating cities but today's SRA should be responsive to the diverse and complex needs of our unique City.

As a long time resident with roots in the community and experience in City government, and as a member of the Union Square CAC and LOCUS strategy leader, I'm familiar with the development opportunities and challenges facing Somerville and importance of the GLX and transit related development. As an SRA board member I would bring a pragmatic, collaborative approach to governance, deliberation, and decision-making and work with fellow members to improve public credibility without changing the SRA's role and responsibilities.

I would welcome an opportunity to progress sound development while preserving our City's diversity and character as an SRA board member. Thank you for your time and consideration.
