<u>Chapter 9, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, Sec. 9-3 (b) of the Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:</u>

(b) No person shall give, sell, or deliver or consume marijuana or tetrahydrocannabinol, unless
licensed by the Licensing Commission and the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Cannabis Control
Commission and also permitted under Sections SZO 7.15 or 7.16.
