Street Cleaning even side of Oak Street. At 6 Oak Street there are 3 trucks with Construction Permits AND tickets for parking illegally for street cleaning.

Permit is \$35/month , 4 tickets for 4 days/month of street cleaning violations is \$200. \$235 a month for parking is a "write off"/just a cost of doing business with no consideration for the neighborhood.

At minimum permits should be capped per project, monitored for appropriate use and cancelled after a certain #of parking violations. Without stricter guidelines and enforcement we are justifying providing incentives to contractors at a cost to residents.
