

(3) Construction. Unless otherwise authorized by the enforcing authority, based on consideration of the factors contained in section 9-114 of this chapter, the public convenience and consultation with the ward councilor, it shall be unlawful to:

(a) operate or permit the operation of any tools, pile drivers, hammers or equipment used in construction, drilling, demolition, or similar work, or otherwise conduct any related activity before 7:00 a.m. and after 7:00 p.m. on weekdays, or before 9:00 a.m. and after 7:00 p.m. on Saturdays, and the day after Thanksgiving and Christmas (unless such day falls on a Sunday), or anytime on Sundays and Massachusetts Legal Holidays (as published by the Secretary of the Commonwealth), such that the sound therefrom creates a noise disturbance.

(b) In addition to the limitations set forth in paragraph (a) above, it shall be unlawful to operate or permit the operation of the following machinery or activities after 5:00 p.m. on weekdays, or anytime on Saturdays such that the sound therefrom creates a noise disturbance.

- (1) Drilling rigs
- (2) Pile driving or impact hammer rigs
- (3) Blasting or explosive equipment of any kind.
- (4) Heavy-duty crushing machinery, including rock crushing equipment
- (5) Jack hammers
- (6) Concrete or masonry saws
- (7) Sand or abrasive blasting
