- (3) Construction. Unless otherwise authorized by the enforcing authority, based on consideration of the factors contained in section 9-114 of this chapter, the public convenience and consultation with the ward councilor, it shall be unlawful to:
- (a) operate or permit the operation of any tools, pile drivers, hammers or equipment used in construction, drilling, demolition, or similar work, or otherwise conduct any related activity before 7:00 a.m. and after 7:00 p.m. on weekdays, or before 9:00 a.m. and after 7:00 p.m. on Saturdays, and the day after Thanksgiving and Christmas (unless such day falls on a Sunday), or anytime on Sundays and Massachusetts Legal Holidays (as published by the Secretary of the Commonwealth), such that the sound therefrom creates a noise disturbance.
- (b) In addition to the limitations set forth in paragraph (a) above, it shall be unlawful to operate or permit the operation of the following machinery or activities after 5:00 p.m. on weekdays, or anytime on Saturdays such that the sound therefrom creates a noise disturbance.
 - (1) Drilling rigs
 - (2) Pile driving or impact hammer rigs
 - (3) Blasting or explosive equipment of any kind.
 - (4) Heavy-duty crushing machinery, including rock crushing equipment
 - (5) Jack hammers
 - (6) Concrete or masonry saws
 - (7) Sand or abrasive blasting
