Dear President McLaughlin,

Thank you for contacting Tufts University regarding our dining employees. They are an important part of our workforce, and we appreciate their contributions to our community.

Tufts University does not determine eligibility for unemployment benefits. Those determinations are made by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and there are a variety of factors that are considered. Although the Commonwealth made certain exceptions last summer due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this year – as in years past - employees who are scheduled to be off for the summer but who have a reasonable expectation of returning to work in the fall are generally not eligible to receive unemployment benefits. Consistent with our long-standing practice, Tufts has provided letters to dining employees who are expected to return to work next fall.
