

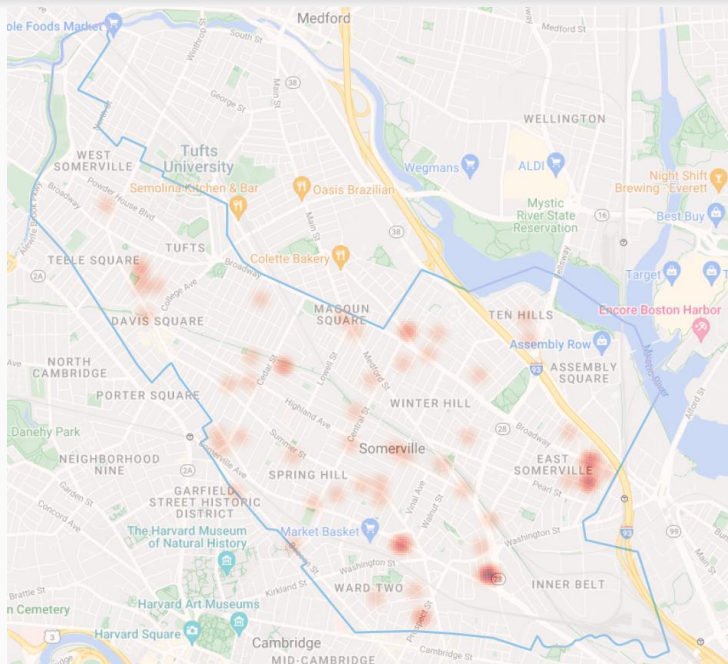

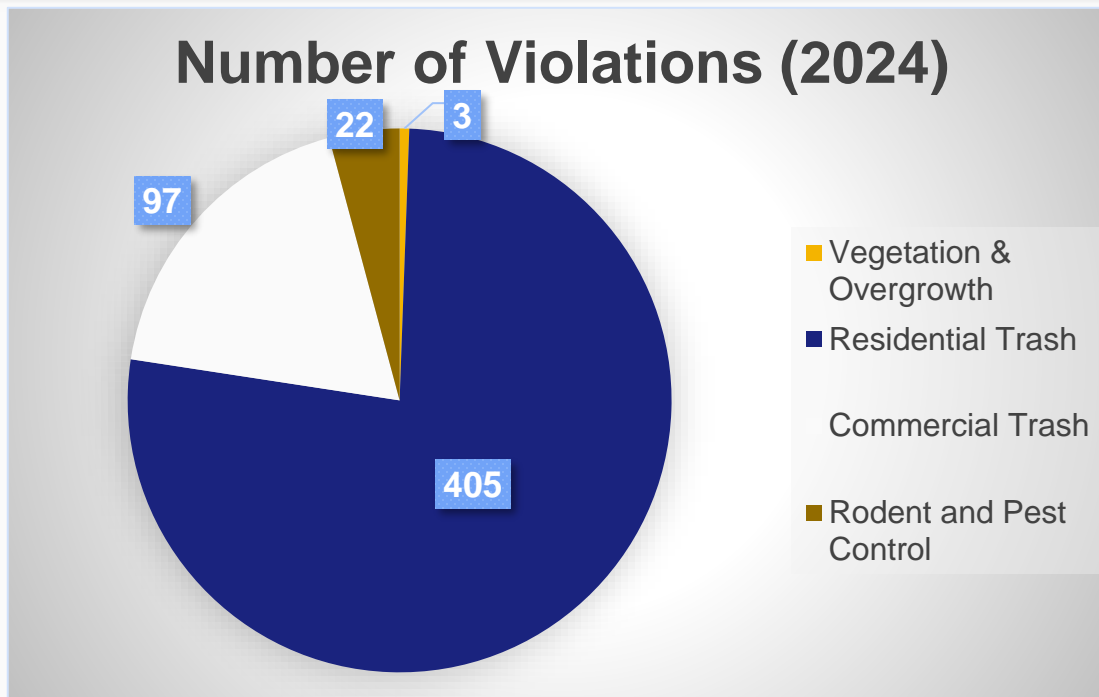

Rodenticide Restrictions

Rodenticide (SGARs) use will be banned from public properties such as schools and parks. DPW has confirmed this and is currently in conversations with their contractors about alternatives.

Poison use change for residential program confirmed as of 2/23

We are working on a IPM guide for all City related construction projects when consulting with contractors on rodent management plans to restrict SGAR use.

We are working on IPM guides with DPW for schools.

Carbon Monoxide and Dry Ice is being used for burrow treatment.

Using Terad3 Blox (cholecalciferol) as bait to reduce the risk of secondary poisoning.
