Dear Chief Fallon,

The Mayor's Office of Emergency Management (OEM) is pleased to notify you that Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) 2014 funding under the Critical Infrastructure Investment Area can support the City of Somerville's target hardening project involving the installation of two surveillance cameras outside Somerville City Hall.

OEM is able to support the cost of this initiative not to exceed four-thousand five-hundred sixty dollars and nine cents (\$4,560.09). The project must conform to the specifications contained within FEMA's Records of Environmental Consideration Report regarding Environmental and Historic Preservation (EHP). At this time you are free to enter into contract to receive the desired services. Said contract must comply with Chapter 30B of the Massachusetts General Laws. Once work is completed and invoices have been paid please submit the invoices, purchase orders and proof of payment to OEM for reimbursement. All work must be completed by July 31, 2016.
