# COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE FY21 FUNDING RECOMMENDATION FOR HEALEY SCHOOL TOT LOT RENOVATION, CITY OF SOMERVILLE PUBLIC SPACE AND URBAN FORESTRY

# **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The City of Somerville and Friends of the Healey will procure a firm to renovate the Healey school tot lot, which is the primary outdoor play and learning environment for students in pre-K through Grade 2.

# **ELIGIBILITY**

Open space/recreation land: This project will rehabilitate outdoor recreation land.

#### **RECOMMENDED FUNDING**

On November 18, 2020, by a vote of 9-0, the Community Preservation Committee recommended appropriating \$375,578 for this project, \$272,108 from open space and recreation land reserve budget and \$103,470 from the budgeted reserve to the control of the City of Somerville Public Space and Urban Forestry Division for the overall purposes summarized in this document.
