Hello,

My name is Reid Moulis and I'm a ward 2 resident writing on behalf of Boston Bike Polo. Hardcourt bike polo is a global sport with a ruleset, referees, and specialized equipment. It is played by all ages and all genders, and people from all walks of life. World championships were held in Taiwan just a few weeks ago, and Boston Bike Polo was proud to send a few of our members!

We play 3-5 times a week during good weather. However, the lights at our main court (Willie O'Ree rink in lower Allston) shut off for the winter in late November, and our winter court (Burns playground, Cambridge) is in poor condition and often snowed or iced out.

The founder's non-ice rink is a perfect court for bike polo. The size, court surface, and boards are all excellent, which is very rare. Coupled with it being out of the weather, it's a truly exceptional court. We'd love to be able to rent/use it, especially through the winter.
