  - **2. 211213: Discuss** ()- Directors of Health and Human Services and Inspectional Services conveying a Residential Rodent Control Assistance Program update.
  - **3. 210381: Discuss** (Strezo)- That the Director of Inspectional Services communicate with the community via mail, email and/or other means, its 2020 plan for combating rat infestations, including monthly updates during peak infestation periods and quarterly updates otherwise.
  - **4. 209824: Discuss** (Rossetti)- That the Director of Communications utilize the CTY system, in April, to send out a high-alert to remind residents not to put out water or food for birds, as a method to help combat the rodent issue.

**5. 210745: Discuss** (Scott, McLaughlin, Clingan, Mbah)- That the Commissioner of Public Works address the fragility of the trash collection bins in relation to the rat population and inform this Council as to the duration and nature of the contract providing said bins to the City.
