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



Push for our Troops

Sir,

I have reviewed the Public Event Permit Application and spoken with the event coordinator for the Push for our Troops event scheduled for May 12, 2012. The event consists of one man pushing a 600 lb wheelbarrow along a 13 mile course. The event is scheduled to start in Charlestown and travel through Somerville and into Medford. The route for the Somerville portion will travel up Mystic Ave from the Charlestown Line, left onto Lombardi Way, right onto Broadway then right onto Boston Ave to the Medford Line. The event coordinator estimates his arrival at the Somerville Line at approximately 9:00 a.m. and that it will take approximately two hours to traverse the Somerville portion of the route.

The Middlesex Sheriffs Department is providing two motorcycles and a cruiser for the escort along the entire route. I have forward the application to Chief Carvalho of the Somerville Auxiliary Police Department with a request that he provides officers for the event to ensure a Somerville Police presence.

I recommend the permit application be approved.
