- 1. This permit is issued annually and is valid through December 31.
- 2. The Applicant agrees to use only those items described in the description and attached plan, and place all items on the sidewalk or public way in such a manner as not to obstruct pedestrian traffic and to permit an unobstructed path of travel in accordance with applicable federal and state law. The Applicant agrees to maintain a minimum clearance of 42" on the sidewalk or public way at all times.
- 3. The Applicant agrees to submit a City and County Licenses and Permits Bond in the amount of \$5,000, or a current Certificate of Insurance listing the City of Somerville as an Additional Insured on the business liability insurance in a form satisfactory to the City before the Permit will be issued.
- 4. The Applicant agrees to remove all goods and other property from the sidewalk or public way no later than 9:00 PM, except for outdoor seating, which shall be maintained per #5 below.
- 5. For outdoor seating,
 - a. The Applicant agrees to comply at all times with 248 CMR 10.10 (minimum toilet facilities), and hereby certifies that the Applicant has sufficient toilet facilities to accommodate the maximum indoor and outdoor seating capacity.
 - b. The Applicant agrees to install a containment system, which is satisfactory to the City, around the periphery of the outdoor seating area in order to delineate and separate the proposed use from the public sidewalk or public way.
 - c. The Applicant agrees to close all outdoor seating no later than 10:00 PM.
 - d. The Applicant acknowledges that the service of alcohol in the outdoor seating area is prohibited, and may result in criminal and/or civil sanctions, unless separately licensed by the Licensing Commission.
 - e. The Applicant agrees to the placement and regular maintenance of a trash receptacle on the sidewalk or public way in front of the business in order to minimize extra litter associated with outdoor seating.

I am writing on behalf of Forge Baking Company to inform the City of Somerville that we take full responsibility in ensuring the upkeep, maintenance and safety of the parklet as below:

1. Design Standards:

- Parklets must be designed as an elevated platform that is flush with the adjacent curb/sidewalk, with no more than a 1/2 inch gap between the platform and the curb/sidewalk.
- Curbside drainage and access to the space beneath the platform must be maintained.
- The platform must be load-bearing and constructed of safe, sturdy, and durable materials manufactured for outdoor use, preferably using recycled or sustainably harvested products. All furnishing must be commercial grade.
- Platforms must include a continuous physical barrier along the perimeter
 of the platform facing any street or parking area that is 36" min to
 42" max. This physical barrier can be visually permeable if a sense
 of security from passing vehicles is maintained.
- Vertical elements (such as plants or moveable table umbrellas) should be used to increase visibility of the platform from vehicles.
- Plantings may be included and integrated into the overall design.

2. Traffic and Parking Standards:

- T& P may require the installation of traffic safety improvements by **DPW**, including but not limited to, traffic markings, flexible reflective bollards, and wheel stops at the applicant's expense.
- Parklets must be publically accessible and signed as such at all times. Signage must be of a contrasting color to improve visibility and permanently attached to the parklet.
- Any movable items, such as tables and chairs, must either be locked down at night or taken inside. Unsecured furniture is not permitted after business hours.

- A maintenance agreement to keep all plants in good health and the
 platform free of debris and grime is required. The surface of the platform
 must be maintained on a daily basis and the space beneath the platform
 must be inspected weekly and any refuse or litter removed.
- **3. The Health Department** may require pest abatement beneath the platform at the applicant's expense.

4. Operational Standards

An approved parklet may be installed and used April 1st – October 30th.

Based on the proposed plans of the seasonal "parklet" slated to occupy 2.75 non-metered street parking spaces (including .75 spaces as part of a city-sponsored bike rack) in front of Forge Baking Company at 626 Somerville Avenue, I support Forge Baking Company's proposal. Forge Baking Company, Somerville, Massachusetts Structural Review of Parklet

Dear Ms. Lewis,

Per your request, I have reviewed the design of the proposed parklet benches and planters as shown on the architectural drawings prepared by Davis Square Architects dated 5/21/2015. The benches and planters are to be constructed with pressure treated 2x4 framing and wood sheathing. All components are to be fastened together with #12 x 3" hot-dipped galvanized wood screws. These structures have sufficient strength to support seated occupants and planting soil. I recommend the following additional measures to prevent accidental overturning of the planters:

- Bench and planters frames must include horizontal 2x4 members at all sides, top and bottom.
- The planters must be fastened to the top and bottom of the benches with 3/8" bolts at 24" on center.
- Short bench sections (perpendicular to the planter) must be connected to the long bench section with two 3/8" bolts top and bottom.
- Bolts must be installed through the 2x4 frame members.
- Diagonal 2x4 members must be provided inside the benches and planters at 48" on center.
