This office represents 272 Broadway, LLC, the owner of the contiguous lots located at 272 Broadway and 8 Kennison Road. My client has submitted plans for the erection of a small office building on the site. The abutter at 266 Broadway is the Broadway Somerville Fire Station.

We were asked to prepare specific easements relative to two issues. There is a side door to the fire station. In order to access the door however, it is necessary for those having the right to enter or exit to cross over the land of my client. The land in question will be adjacent to the building and the easement goes only so far as to permit access to the side door. The second issue is that there is a generator on a generator pad in the 8 Kennison Road lot to which the Fire Department will, from time to time, require access for maintenance. Because the generator pad straddles the line between the two properties, it is unclear as to whether the easement is actually needed but it would appear prudent to grant it. The easement is akin to a utility easement.
