

**First Amendment to Memorandum of Agreement 53183 between the City of Boston Mayor's Office of Emergency Management and the City of Somerville**

The Memorandum of Agreement 53183, dated July 1, 2021, by and between the City of Boston Mayor's Office of Emergency Management (hereinafter "Boston OEM"), acting by and through its Director, and the City of Somerville, acting by and through its Mayor, referred hereinafter collectively as "the Parties", is hereby amended as follows:

**I. Scope of Services**

There will be no changes to the scope of services of this Memorandum of Agreement.

**II. Term of Agreement**

This amendment will extend the end date of the agreement twelve (12) months to a new end date of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

**III. Funding**

No change will be made to the original funding limit of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000).

This amendment will provide an end date extension that incorporates the UASI FFY21 grant (outlined below). This grant funding will expire on the deadline of June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Additionally, this amendment encompasses two UASI grant end date extensions, as directed by the Massachusetts Executive Office of Public Safety and Security (EOPPS):

- a. FFY18 will now expire on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022, and;
- b. FFY19 will now expire on June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

The City of Somerville will continue its active role in the annual Funding Allocation process, and all subsequent meetings on the allocation and reallocation of funds. In conjunction with this, the City of Somerville will name an individual to be the Jurisdictional Point of Contact (JPOC) to work with the Boston OEM financial staff as outlined in the original MOA.

The City of Somerville will continue its active role in the annual strategy and program reviews, and all subsequent meetings on the direction of Homeland Security initiatives.

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




