



Somerville Honor Run - Alternative Course #2 Sunday, November 11, 2018 @ 9:30AM.

Runners will congregate on Herbert St then line up near the corner of Herbert & Chester. When the race starts runners turn right on Chester St, left on Cottage Ave, left on Russell St, right on Summer St, left on Vinal Ave, right on Aldersey St, right on Walnut St, left on Columbus Ave, left on Prospect Hill Pkwy, left on Munroe St, right on Walnut St, left on Summit Ave, left on Vinal Ave, right on Summer St to finish line on Summer St & Cutter. [Summer St & Vinal Ave will have cones placed in the middle of the street so we can utilize both sides of the road to create an out and back loop course].
