

NO Mobil to Be served Tout 4/4/13

City Sports requested to hold its 30th anniversary 10 k road race in or city. The number of runners is between 750 and 1000 runners. The original permit called for the race to be held on a Saturday in June. This was not accepted nor was the course that was originally proposed. There were also some questions as to how this was beneficial to our city.

I met on 4/3/2013 with the event coordinator (Kelly Fattman) to discuss these issues.

The first issue was addressed by moving the date to June 30th 2013. This is a Sunday which is more in line with other events of this nature. The race if accepted is rain or shine.

The second issue addressed was the course. The course was modified to utilize the rear municipal lot behind Rite Aid Pharmacy as the staging area. The course also utilized the bike path as its starting and finishing point. The bike path is 4.3 tenths of a mile which eliminates almost one mile of the 6.2 mile course. The course route is attached. The course is predominately in Ward Seven away from the Square areas. One of the reasons it was moved is because the students will be on summer break. The new course would not require shutting of any roadways or re-routing of the MBTA. Although this is one of the longest races we've hosted, by repeating some of the race on roadways already ran it would limit the impact on traffic flow. The course was also designed to utilize as many roads with bike lanes as possible. From a Public Safety point of view it would be one of the easier ones to monitor. Note: The event coordinator is open to modifications if needed.

The third issue, how it benefits Somerville. The event coordinator changed the cover letter to address this. It appears City Sports would like to become involved in our community because of our demographics. They have indicated an interest in becoming a partner with the City by offering to donate financially or equipment to one of our non-profit health and fitness programs. Through our conversations it was indicated preferably to a youth program.

The event coordinator was open as to how many Police and Fire details would be needed and agreed to leave that to the respective departments.

I have reviewed the changes and recommend the permit be approved.
