1. Approval of the February 4, 2015 Minutes

- 2. 198457: Public Hearing New Garage License Top Car Auto The applicants appeared and noted that this location was previously an auto parts business.
- **3. 198459 : Public Hearing New Mobile Food License Pennypackers** Applicant Kevin McGuire spoke on the item and stated that the owner wants to be named on the certificate of insurance.
- **4. 198460 : Public Hearing New Mobile Food License Rythym n Wraps** Applicant Aaron Cohen appeared before the committee.
- 5. 198534: Public Hearing Used Car Dealer's License Class II Alewife Automotive
 Three applicants appeared from Alewife Automotive in support of the item. Two residents spoke saying that 50 cars would be too many for the community. Residents said that the applicant has been better with regards to cars on the street and the lot, however the community does not want a used car lot in the neighborhood.

196760: That the Administration create a process to evaluate public events for financial impacts on city resources, and use it for all public event applications.
