Sir,

I have reviewed the Public Event Permit Application for the Stereo Drive By Concert scheduled for September 24, 2011. All aspects of the permit appear in order. I spoke to Vincent Micucci (event coordinator) regarding my concern that event goers may block the sidewalks forcing pedestrians into the street. He stated that they have invited approximately 50 family and friends to attend the event. That he hoped to draw some interest from people visiting Davis Square but he did not anticipate drawing a crowd large enough to interfere with pedestrian traffic.

I recommend the permit application be approved with the condition that if pedestrian traffic is obstructed as a result of the event the band must discontinue their performance.
