My family emigrated to this country because of antisemitism. I have personal experiences with violations of human rights. Unfortunately it seems that there is no safe haven from such violations which is why there is a need for groups such as the HRC to help disseminate important information and to help advocate for corrective measures.

I am a semi-retired psychotherapist. In my work with individuals I help people work through issues that interfere with their ability to have full and satisfied lives. I think of the work of the HRC as being somewhat similar in that the attempt is to help remove barriers that limit ones human rights and thus open up opportunities for a better life.
