I am pleased to inform you that the Department of Energy Resources (DOER) Green Communities Division has approved an award of \$191,075 for the following projects proposed in the city of Somerville's Green Communities Competitive Grant application.

List of projects funded:

- \$68,706, JFK Elementary School—Lighting upgrade
- \$31,956, JFK Elementary School— Lighting controls upgrade
- \$4,585, Brown School— Boiler damper
- \$11,610, Edgerly Education Center— Mechanical insulation
- \$62,667, Edgerly Education Center — Steam trap repair
- \$4,860, Edgerly Education Center —Steam register thermostats
- \$2,198, Central Library—AHU fan motor replacement
- \$1,961, Senior Center—Pipe insulation
- \$2,532, Senior Center—Thermostats

The Division reviewed Somerville's grant application and has determined these are viable projects that meet the eligibility requirements of our Competitive Grant program. **Please note that, due to the competitive nature of this grant program, the use of these funds is restricted to the specifically-approved projects listed above.**
