Complaint Description:

There has been constant noise since last night. This morning at 06:30 there was noise every 30 seconds. This has been going on all week.

Massport Report Investigation:

You are affected by jet departures from Runway 33L, in use with light winds, high air traffic demand, runway closures for maintenance (Runway 4L/22R from 04:53 to 10:58 and Runway 4R/22L from 08:33 to 10:58) and following the FAA standard operating procedure. Runway 33L was used as the secondary departure runway from 05:09 to 07:00 and as the primary departure runway from 07:00 to 10:55. Historically RW33L is used at a higher level from October until early April, due to prevailing westerly/northwesterly winds. However, changes in weather and runway closures also affect usage. For your information, we are including the Year to Date Runway Usage Report, "How Logan Operates", "Noise FAQ", and "Noise Abatement". You could also use "Flight Monitor".
