You are hereby notified that the Board of Aldermen will hold a Public Hearing on the following Petition. You are receiving this Notice because City records indicate that you own property that abuts the work that is being proposed. You and other members of the public are invited to attend and be heard at this Hearing.

Drainage: Construct 6 new double grated catch basins, 4 new drain manholes, 130 feet of PVC drainage pipe and 240 feet of RCP drainage pipe within Washington Street to collect and convey storm water away from the underpass of the Washington Street Bridge.

Water: Construct 50 feet of CLDI water from the new GLX Washington Street Station to an existing water main in the north side of Washington Street.

TIME: Thursday, January 22, 2015, at 7:00 PM.

PURPOSE: The work is necessary to install and upgrade utilities for the Washington Street Station portion of the Green Line Extension Project – Washington Street.

Dear Board Members:

Preliminary approval is recommended for the petition and plan of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority to:

For drainage: Construct six (6) new double grated catch basins, four (4) new drain manholes, one hundred thirty (130') linear feet of (12") PVC drainage pipe and two hundred forty (240') linear feet of (36") RCP drainage pipe within Washington Street to collect and convey storm water away from the underpass of Washington Street Bridge Somerville, MA.

For Sanitary Sewer: Construct (40') linear feet of new 8" PVC sanitary sewer line from the new GLX Washington Street Station to an existing manhole in Washington Street Somerville, MA.

For Water: Construct (50') linear feet of both 6" CLDI water and 8" CLDI water from the new GLX Washington Street Station to an existing water main in the North side of Washington Street, Somerville, MA.

This recommendation is made with reference to MBTA's letter of November 7, 2014 and plan of July 30, 2014 upon stipulation that the Grant of Location is subject to: a reservation of rescission by the Board of Aldermen; indemnification of the City for all liability arising from said Grant; all permit procedures, conditions and approvals of municipal utilities; protection of existing infrastructure; and complete surface repair, restoration and maintenance. A public hearing will be required.

This work is necessary for the install and upgrade of utilities for the Washington Street Station portion of the Green Line Extension Project – Washington Street, Somerville, MA.

Dear Mr. Long,

The Green Line Extension (GLX) project is an initiative of the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) and the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA) to extend Green Line service from a relocated Lechmere Station in Cambridge to Union Square in Somerville and to College Avenue in Medford. As part of the public transit improvements, several water, storm drain and sanitary sewer utilities will be relocated and/or new services provided to new train stations in Somerville, MA. Attached to this letter are narratives, a spreadsheet, and 11x17 plans that depict and describe instances where a municipal utility (water, drain, and sewer) is proposed to be constructed and or relocated in a permanent condition within the City of Somerville's Public Right of Way as part of IGMP#2, IGMP#3, and IGMP#4 packages of the GLX project.

As a result, MBTA is petitioning the City of Somerville for Grant of Locations at the following locations.

- Washington Street below and immediately to the east the existing RR Bridge
- The north end of Horace Street
- Within Bennett Street and the south side of the Prospect Street Bridge
- Inner Belt Road between 70 and 200 Inner Belt Road

There will be several other utility relocations and new services proposed as part of the project in either subsequent IGMP packages or by third party utility companies for electric, fiber, gas, and telecommunication utilities, however, the Grant of Location petitions for those relocations and services will be performed at a later date and or by the third party utility companies.

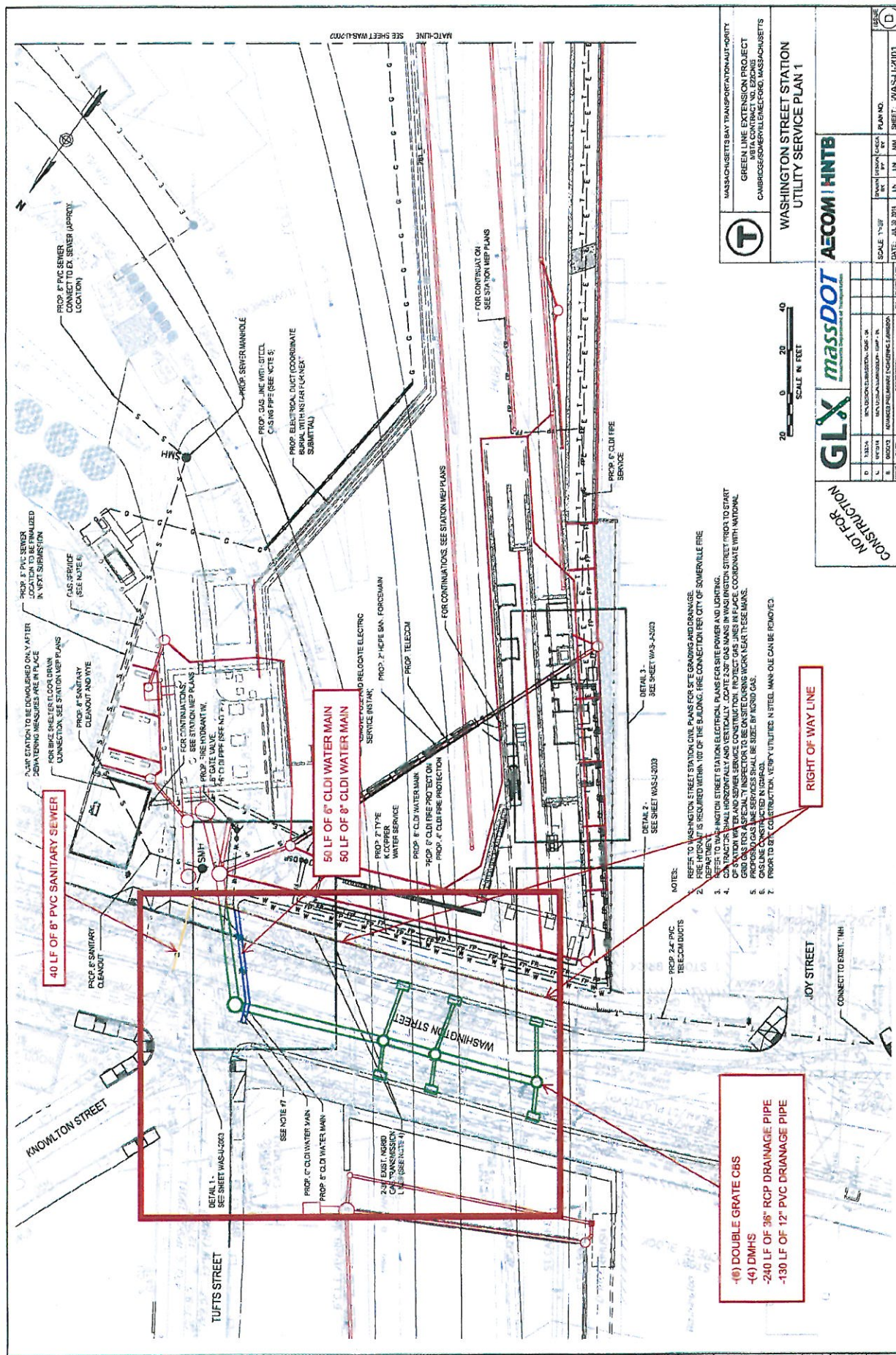
