- 1. Approval of the February 22, 2017 Minutes
- **2. 201988: Discuss** (Ballantyne) That the Superintendent of Inspectional Services inspect 33-35 Barton Street weekly for continual overgrowth onto the public sidewalk.
- **3. 202335: Discuss** (Heuston) That the Superintendent of Inspectional Services inspect 18 School Street for building and health code violations and contact the property owner to make necessary repairs.
- **4. 202865: Discuss** (Lafuente, White Jr., Sullivan) That the Superintendent of Inspectional Services take steps to revoke all licenses held by the Winter Hill Market at 269 Broadway.
- **5. 202877: Discuss** (Niedergang) That the Superintendent of Inspectional Services report to this Board on the extent to which City inspectors enforce snow and ice removal in the city, broken down by ward, in response to complaints that many sidewalks were never cleared.
- **6. 203002: Discuss** (Connolly, Rossetti, White Jr., Sullivan, McWatters) That the Superintendent of Inspectional Services inspect 161 Lowell Street for all violations.
- **7. 202617: Discuss** (McLaughlin, and the Entire Board) That the Administration advocate for sound barriers along I-93 in East Somerville to help reduce air pollution by up to 50 percent.
