Our Company will be prepping the Tufts locations on Sunday, September 29th from approximately7am until 7pm. We would like the ability to pull some of our rigging trucks in the spaces on CollegeAvenue during the

prep day. Tufts has an event on Campus, and we may have to move out of the Tisch Library loading dock if we need to get out of the events way. We would have only (3) 40' foot box trucks for prep that we may want to pull onto College Avenue on Sunday.

I am also going to ask for a little more parking than we anticipated on College Avenue. - Request to hold parking for base camp and crew parking in Dilboy Stadium

- * Note: Our Catering truck will be serving a walking breakfast to the crew as they park. Do we need to apply for any special permits for their hot truck? Fire Detail?
- Request to hold parking for work/rigging trucks West side of College Avenue Between Talbot Ave. and Powder House Square.
- Request to hold spill over parking for working/rigging trucks on North side of Powder House Blvd. just off Powder House Triangle.
- Request to hold parking for picture both side of Powder House Blvd. 120 ft from the corner of Curtis St. three car lengths. This is the static exterior shot of 162 Powderhouse Blvd. No principal actors, just exterior shots of the house. We will have a 2 to 3 person camera crew. We just do not want any cars blocking the view of the house. The time this will take place will be TBD, we will notify the officer on duty when we will move over on the day.
