- Weak Tie Breaking -- Backward

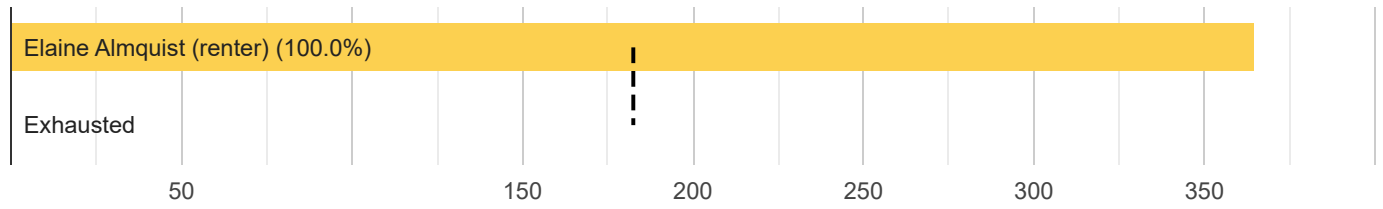
The bar charts below show the vote counts for each candidate in each round. Place the mouse over a bar to see the number of votes.

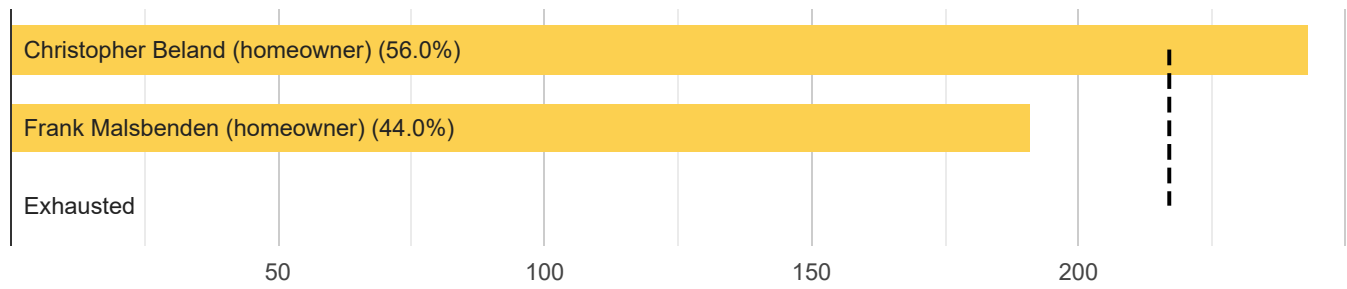

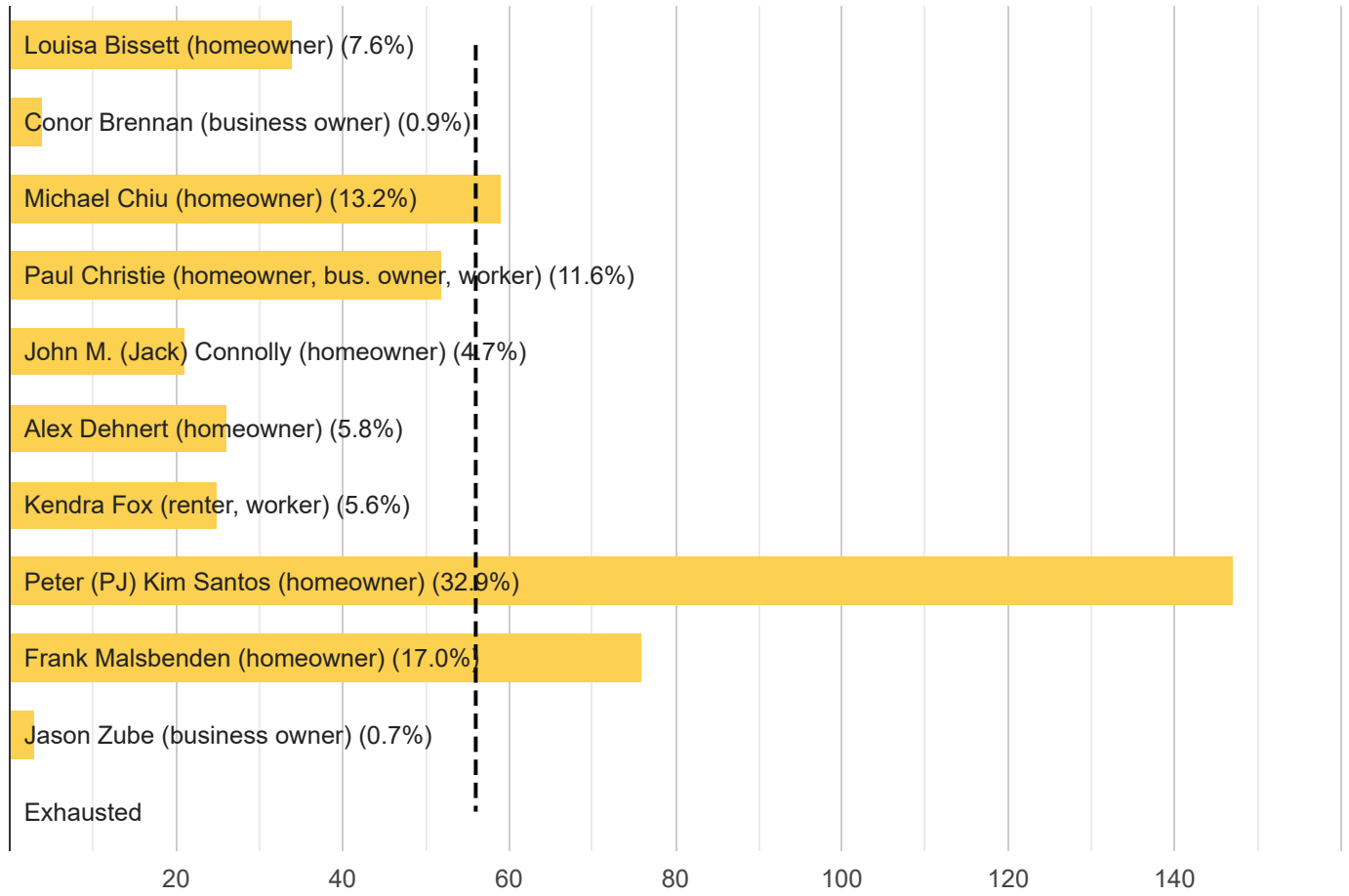

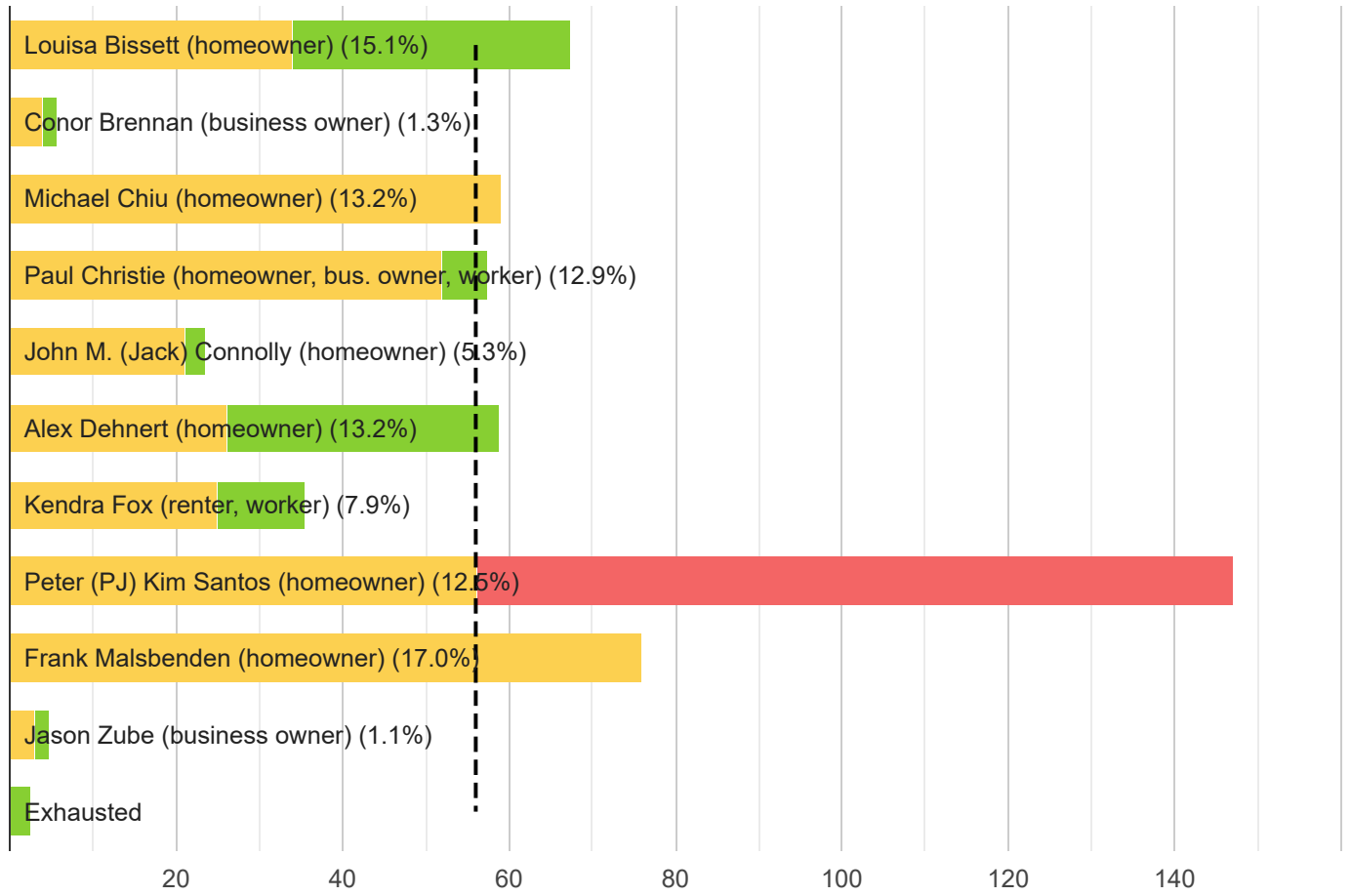

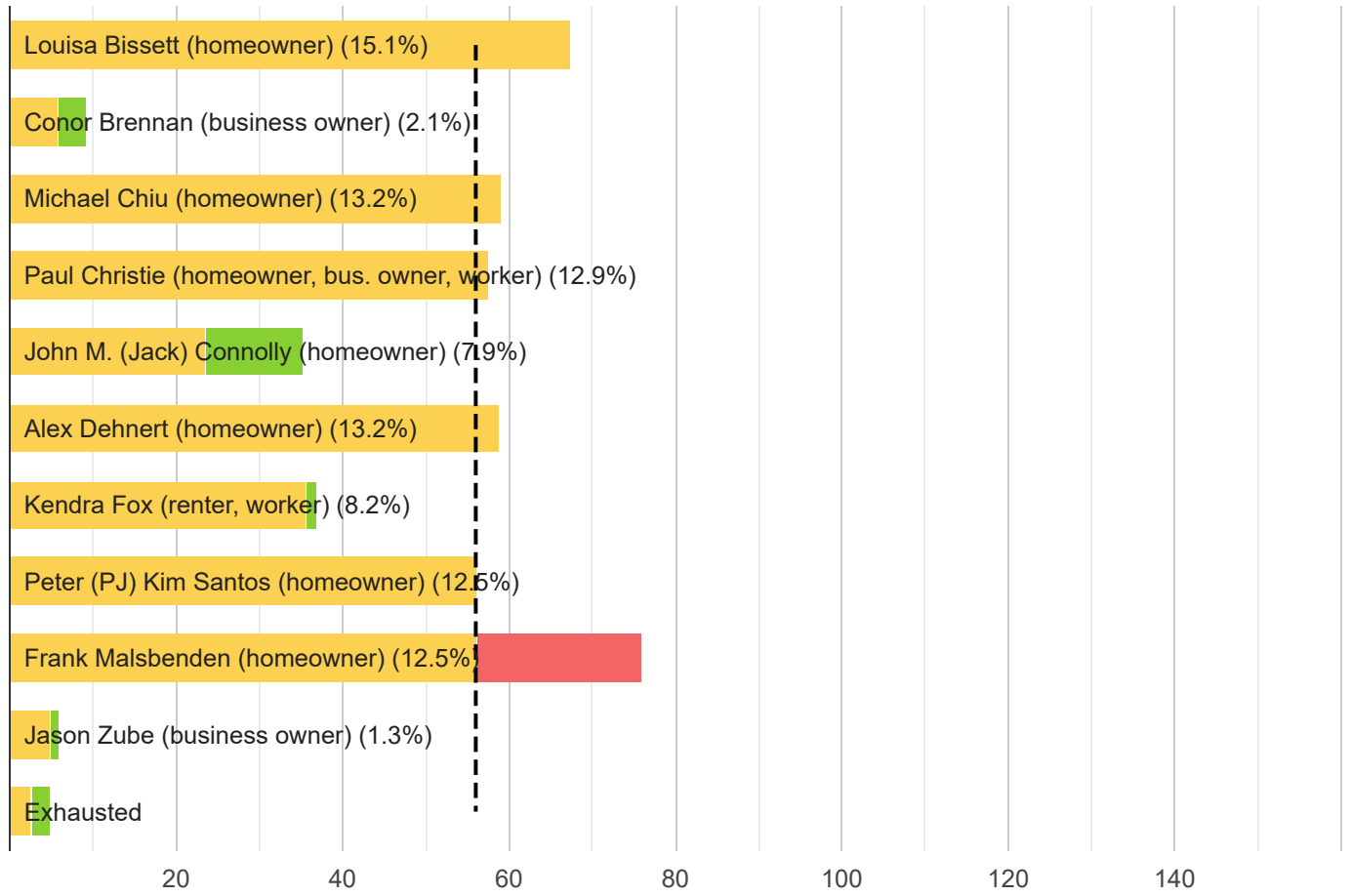

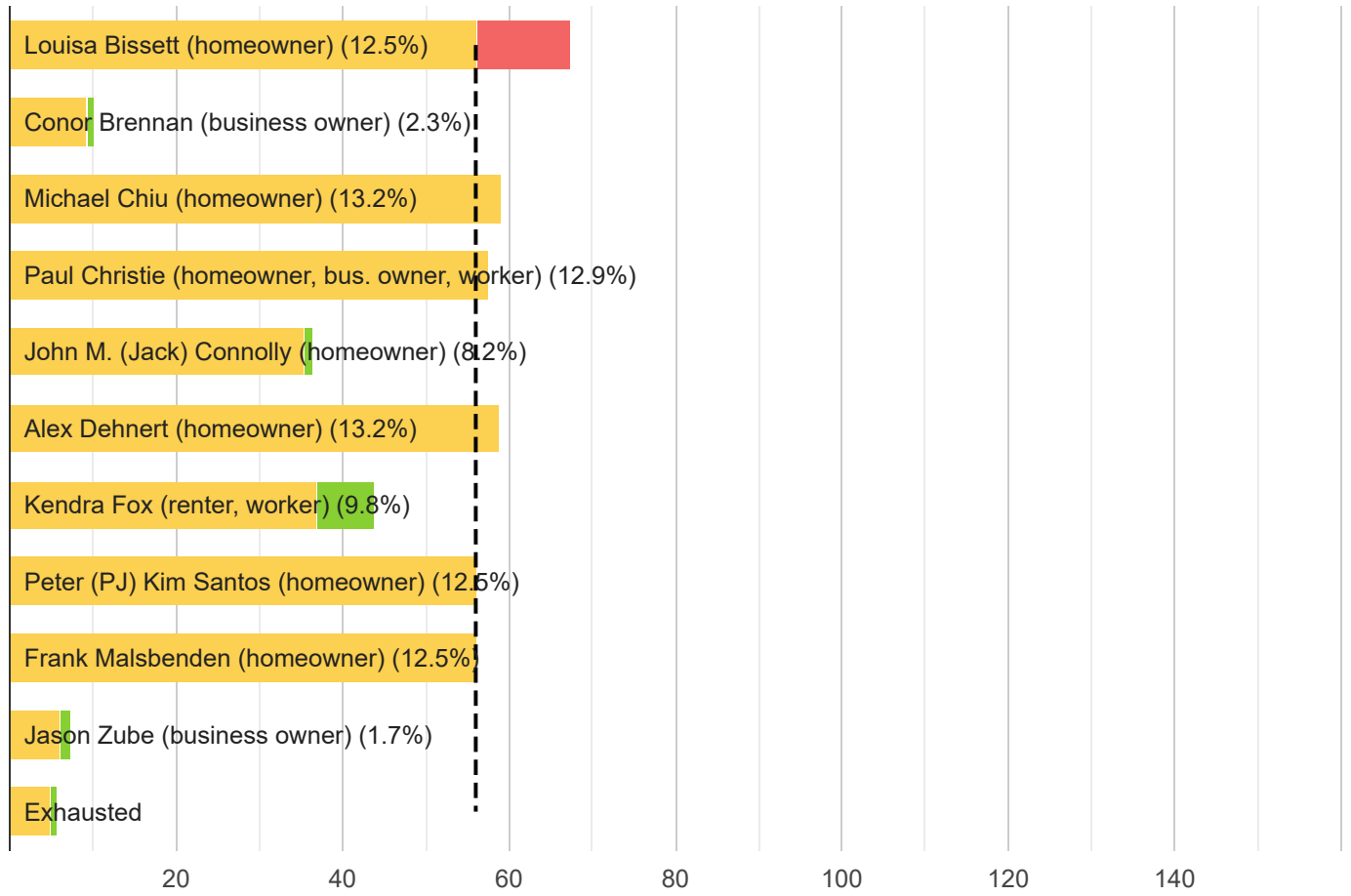

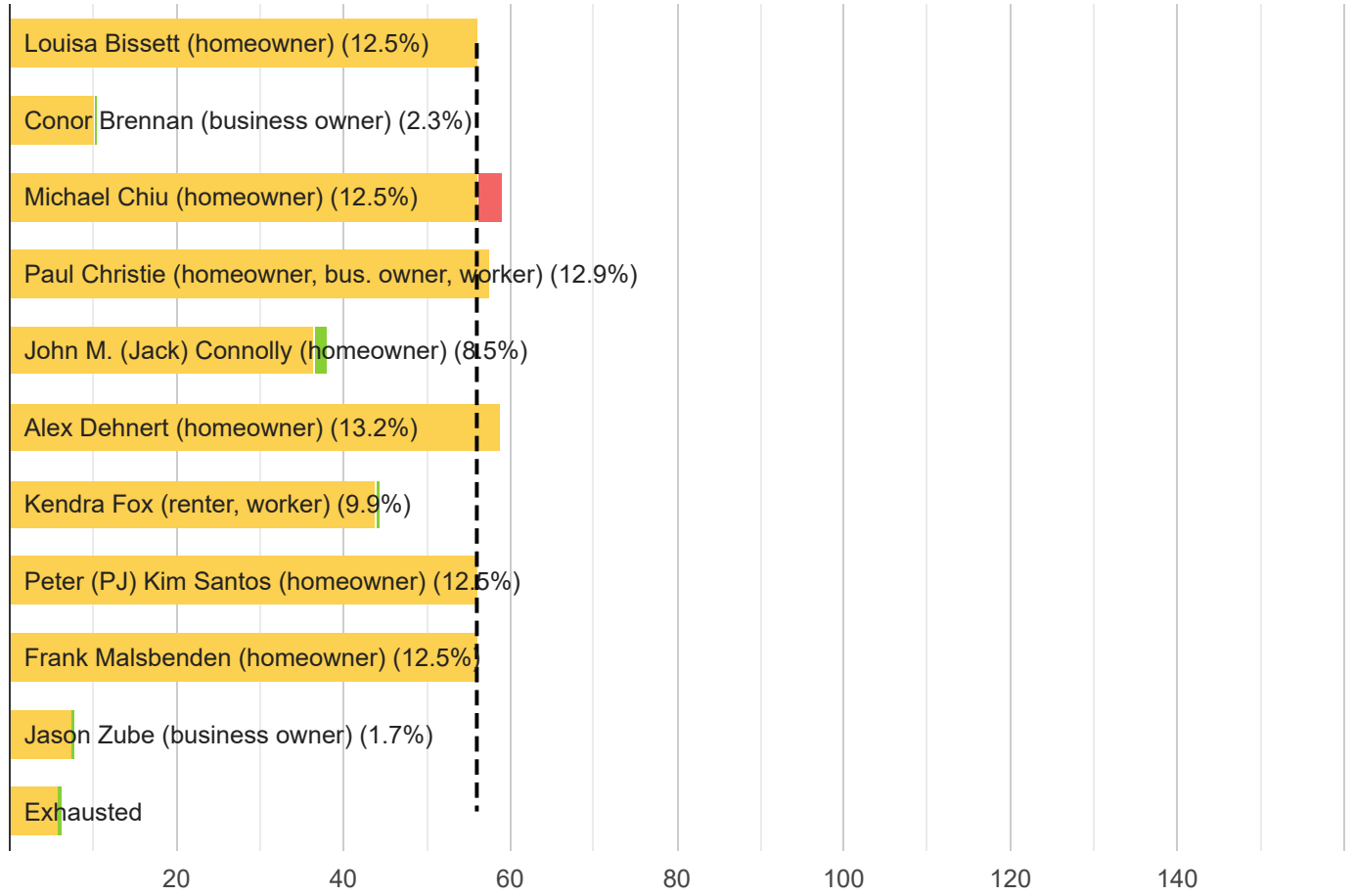

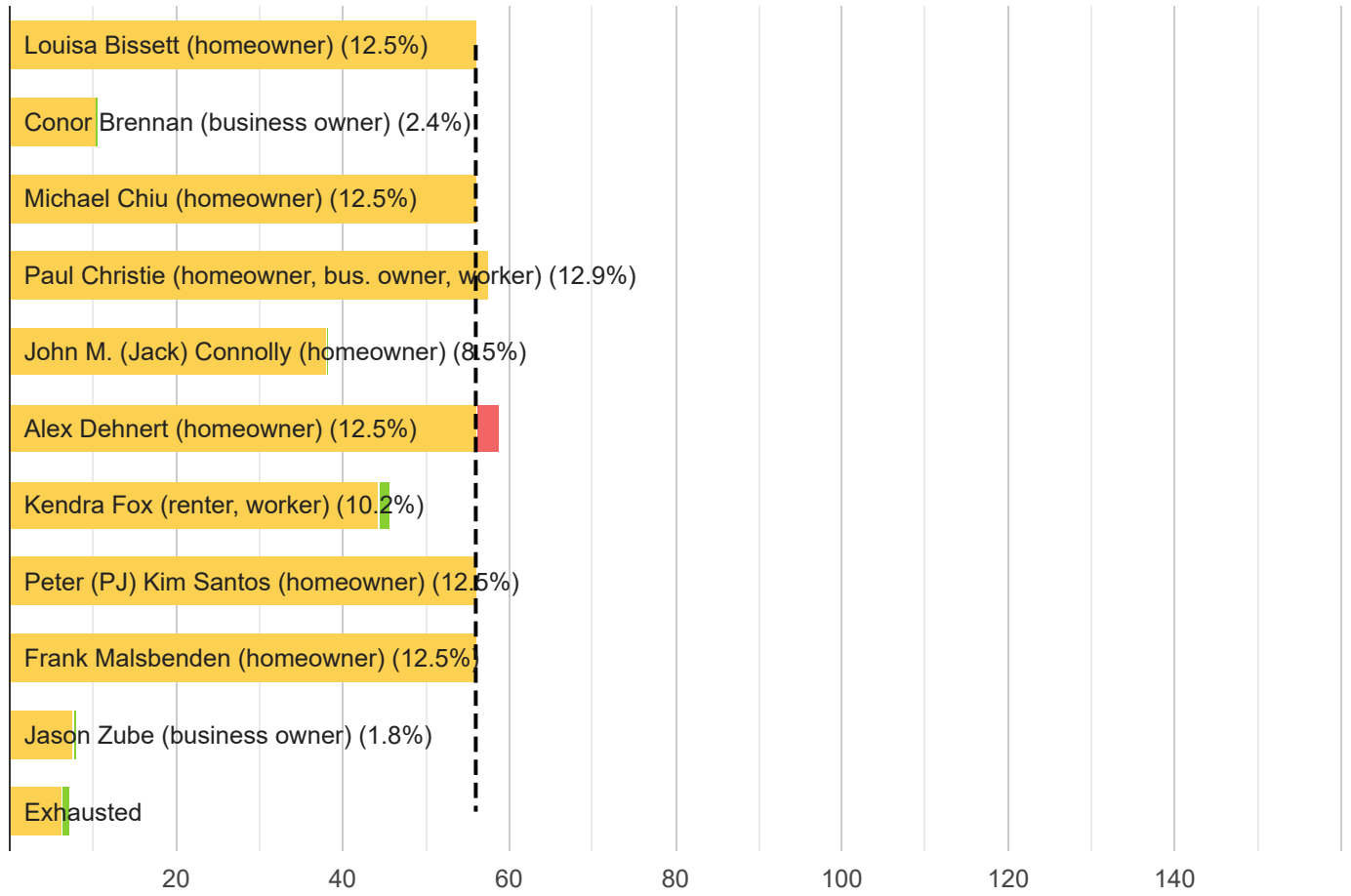

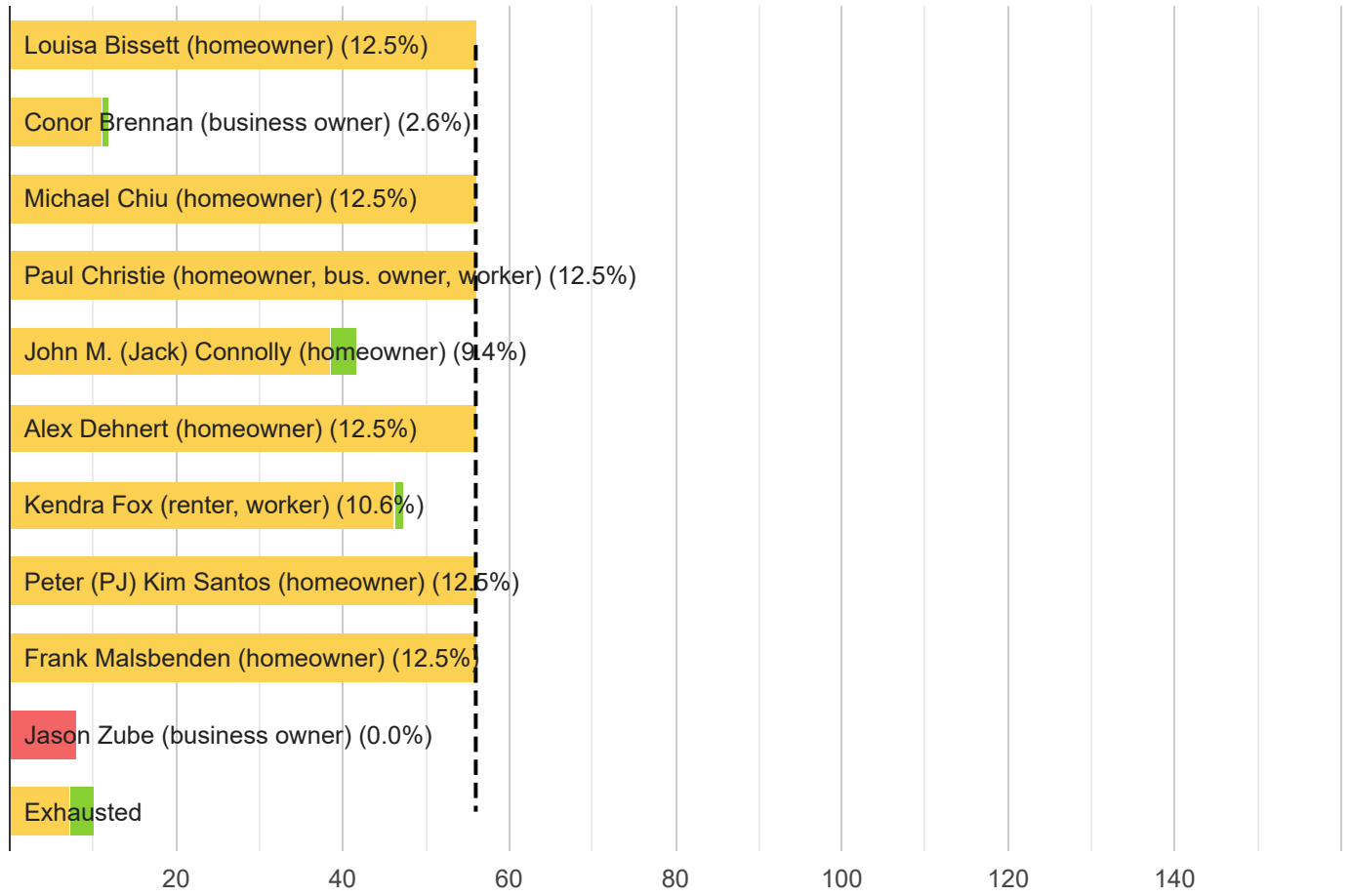
