

The report should include a narrative describing progress towards the specific outcomes identified in your proposal, as well as a complete financial accounting of the use of the grant funds. One month before your report is due we will send an email reminder along with a financial report template for your use. For the narrative portion of your report, the submission of Associated Grant Maker's Common Report Form is also acceptable. The form is available on their web site: www.agmconnect.org. In addition, the Foundation will be in contact with you during the grant year to schedule a phone conversation for the purpose of checking in on the progress of your program.

It is our understanding that Somerville Arts Council has been recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as a tax-exempt organization described in section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. If there is any change in this status, it is your responsibility to notify us at once.

Please acknowledge your receipt of the grant check and your agreement with the terms of this letter by signing and returning the enclosed Letter of Acceptance within ten days. Any public acknowledgement of this grant should indicate that it was received from the Carl and Ruth Shapiro Family Foundation.
