If the applicant requires the use of signage loaned by the Traffic and Parking Department, a security deposit will be required to ensure that the signage is returned.

- 3. If the event is a road race, the applicant will provide race monitors where required by the Police. The applicant will not make permanent marks on the roadway or sidewalk using paint or other indelible materials. Use of chalk will be acceptable. The applicant will pay the cost of removing any indelible marks placed on the roadway or sidewalk.
- 4. If the event is a canning drive, the applicant will provide adult monitors at each location, and will maintain a copy of the approved permit at each location.
- 5. If the event includes a musical performance, the performance will not occur before 9:00 AM or after 10:00 PM, nor at any time on Sunday, nor within 300 feet of any building from which an occupant asks that the performance desist.



RACE DESCRIPTION

The Gobble Gobble

The race continues on Holland Street through Teele Square turning left onto Broadway then a right turn onto North Street and a right onto Powder House Boulevard.

The race continues Powder House Boulevard to Powder House Circle, around the circle and continues on Broadway through Ball Square.

The race continues on Broadway and there is a water stop (staffed by parents and students from Somerville High Track Team) at Trum Field.

Gobble Gobble Thanksgiving Day Road Race - Bill Bryant 617-413-9465

The race continues on Broadway through Magoun Square then turns right onto Medford Street.

The race continues on Medford Street then turns right onto Central Street.

The race continues up Central Street and then turns right onto Summer Street.

The race continues down Summer Street to Elm Street and crosses the intersection of Russell/Cutter Ave and continues to finish line at Elm and Grove Street.

Somerville Auxiliary Police typically divert traffic on Elm Street while runners are finishing the race.

NO PARKING PERMITS & ROAD CLOSURE

To make space for a safe and orderly finish line, no parking permits are requested for spaces in Davis Square on both sides of Elm Street between Holland Street and Grove Street.

Detail Officers from Somerville Police Department, including a Supervisor, work with Somerville Auxiliary Police to briefly hold/divert traffic along the race route.

Significant impacts are:

- on the one way / up hill portion of Central Street between Somerville Ave and Summer Street where the road is closed and traffic diverted.
- At the finish, Elm Street Street is closed and traffic diverted between intersections of Holland/Highland/College and Cutter/Russell.

WATER STOP

There is one water stop located at Trum Field and staffed by parents and students from Somerville High Track Team (Track Pac). Somerville Road Runners provides water and cups, as well as trash bags, and Track Pac folks typically pick up all trash before leaving.

POST RACE AWARDS & CELEBRATION

A post race volunteer party is held in the Burren from 9:30am-12:00noon

No food is served.

RESTROOMS

Rental porta-potties have typically been installed in Ten Hills Park at the edge of the sidewalk along Buena Vista (near intersection of the bike path).

NO PARKING PERMITS & ROAD CLOSURE

To make space for a safe and orderly finish line, no parking permits are requested for spaces in Davis Square on both sides of Elm Street between Holland Street and Grove Street.

Detail Officers from Somerville Police Department, including a Supervisor, work with Somerville Auxiliary Police to briefly hold/divert traffic along the race route.

Significant impacts are:

- on the one way / up hill portion of Central Street between Somerville Ave and Summer Street where the road is closed and traffic diverted.
- At the finish, Elm Street Street is closed and traffic diverted between intersections of Holland/Highland/College and Cutter/Russell.

WATER STOP
