Note the following Conditions:

- 1. The event must not obstruct or inhibit the flow of vehicles or pedestrians except for road closures or detours permitted herein, or as directed by Police Officers or Auxiliary Police Officers.
- 2. All road closures or detours must be approved in advance by the Traffic and Parking Director, and must be implemented with traffic controls specified by the Traffic and Parking Department. Such controls, and any displays or items placed on any street, must be movable at all times. Vehicles must not be used as traffic controls. If the applicant requires the use of signage loaned by the Traffic and Parking Department, a security deposit must be paid to ensure that the signage is returned.
- 3. If the event is a road race, the applicant will provide race monitors where required by the Police. The applicant will not make permanent marks on the roadway or sidewalk using paint or other indelible materials. Use of chalk will be acceptable. The applicant will pay the cost of removing any indelible marks placed on the roadway or sidewalk.

- If the event includes a musical performance, the performance will not occur before 9:00 AM or after 10:00 PM, nor
 at any time on Sunday, except as permitted, nor within 300 feet of any building from which an occupant asks that the
 performance desist.
- 5. Any fees charged by the city are the sole responsibility of the applicant and must be paid in full prior to the event.
- 6. This permit is valid only for the listed location and time, and is subject to all of the terms, conditions, and limitations set forth in the Somerville Code of Ordinances, any applicable State and Federal laws, these conditions, and any other conditions prescribed by the Board of Aldermen and/or stated in the Departmental approvals below.

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

For Saturday's event, here is a detailed list of events and provisions:

- Sally O'Briens: Indoors.
- Prospect Hill Tower: search for clues (non-intrusive for residents)
- UPS Store, Somerville Ave: Indoors.
- Petsi Pies: contestants eat tiny pies, just outside of store.
 - o 2 parking spaces suggested to be blocked for ease of pedestrian/contestant flow.
- East Cambridge Savings Bank (Cedar Street/Highland Ave): Indoors/at teller.
- City Hall: switching from bikes to cars (non-intrusive)
- Flagraphics (Alston St): Indoors.
 - Parking spaces requested for Zip Cars.
- Cross Street Senior Center: Taste test with 4 local restaurants.
 - Staffed by City employee (volunteer)
 - o Permits in-process thru ISD
- Soul. Train. (Teele Square): indoors.
 - o 2 parking spaces requested, may be canceled.
- Tufts: on-campus event
- Lyndell's: 10 sheet cakes will be combined to form one giant (anniversary) cake. Contestants will search thru cake (not eat) for hidden items.
 - Plastic tarp to be laid to avoid larger mess
 - o Parking spots (2) requested in front of business. T&P will create temp. bike lane.
 - O Somerville Auxiliary Police to be stationed to assist with pedestrian flow.
 - No ISD permit necessary
 - o (Local businesses notified, and sponsoring)
- Mike's Pizza: contestants to work with pizza dough, etc. On site, no ISD permit needed.

NOTE: Teams are comprised of 3 contestants each, and will proceed between "challenges" on foot, bike, bus, and Zip Car. Not all teams will arrive in each location at the same time. Each location to be staffed accordingly. ISD, T&P, SPD all notified and proper permits acquired.
