Saturday, March 1st, 3pm-6pm | Outdoors in Union Square Plaza

Fire performers A Different Spin and Ice Sculptor, Don Chapelle from First Night Boston will be doing fire and ice demonstrations in Union Square, Somerville. This event may also include some interactive components by Artisans Asylum and participation from local restaurants and food yendors.

Similar to previous work with these fire performers, we will have a Fire Department detail.

Ides of March

Saturday, March 15th, 1-6pm (Rain/Snow date: Sunday) | Outdoors in Union Square Plaza

To mark the Ides of March and the 2,058th anniversary of the assassination of Julius Caesar, we wish to transform Union Square into a Roman forum for the afternoon. This is not a reenactment or remotely historically accurate proposition - the idea is to engage with the themes of both the historical event and Shakespeare's interpretation of it, as well as the assassination's enduring role in pop cultural memory, in a light-hearted and fun way. A large portion of this will involve a very loose and participatory adaptation of Shakespeare's text, which will involve several different locations in the greater Union Square neighborhood.
