APPROVAL CONDITION: MD20211215: All nearby street tree(s) shall be protected prior to and during all construction activities using TREE BOX or TREE WRAPS. TREE BOX shall be constructed from 2 in. x 4 in. lumber creating a box around the border of the tree pit with 2 in. x 4 in. lumber standing straight up at the corners and wrapped with orange snow fence. 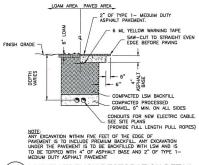


2 TYPICAL UTILITY CROSSING BELOW 04

5 UTILITY TRENCH RESTORATION DETAIL 04

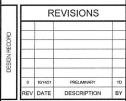
