COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE FY17 FUNDING RECOMMENDATION FOR COMMUNITY PATH SURVEY, CITY OF SOMERVILLE PARKS AND OPEN SPACE DIVISION

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The City of Somerville will hire a firm to conduct a survey of the Somerville Community Path from the Cambridge line to Cedar Street. The survey will be done in preparation for the re-design of the Path, funded by CPA in FY16.

ELIGIBILITY

Open space/recreation land: This project will rehabilitate and restore outdoor recreation land.

RECOMMENDED FUNDING

On April 26, 2017, by a vote of 8-0, the Community Preservation Committee recommended appropriating \$20,000 for this project from the open space and recreation land reserve budget to the control of the City of Somerville for the overall purposes summarized in this document.
