Grant Funding for Tree Root Removal

Alderman Gewirtz:

Please be advised that OSPCD is in receipt of your Board Order #189612, dated May 27, 2010, which request research into grant programs for tree root removal.

OSPCD, in conjunction with DPW Engineering, researched the issue of funding residential sewer repairs. While some states offer financial assistance to residents, Massachusetts does not. The City will continue to explore options regarding this issue. Moreover, street trees are now selected, in large part, based on root systems that extend vertically rather than horizontally. This limits the disruption to both sidewalks and sewer systems.
