Report of the Committee on Confirmation of Appointments and Personnel Matters, meeting on April 6, 2022.

President McLaughlin was recused and Councilor Ewen-Campen assumed the Chair. Councilor Pineda Neufeld presented the Committee Reports, noting her plan to propose that 5 candidates be approved, bringing the total number of police officers to 88. Councilor Kelly presented a Minority Report for the April 7th meeting recommending that 3 candidates not be approved. Director Sahni stated that the administration stands behind all 8 candidates, and acknowledged that this is a complex conversation. Councilor Scott expressed concerns about the procedure going forward and suggested holding on any action on these items until outside counsel may provide the Council with an opinion on this. Director Sahni noted that 2 candidates, if they are approved, would begin on May 9th at the Police Academy. Deputy Stanford stated that the top 2 candidates have already completed the academy. Councilor Clingan commented that there seems to be agreement on 5 candidates and he stated the need for additional police officers. Councilor Strezo sponsored Maggie Joseph to speak. Ms. Joseph stated that the Mystic Ave/Temple Street area is not safe and asked for additional police in the area. Councilor Clingan said that 1 officer for 12,000 people seems low and his constituents are calling for additional police. Councilor Gomez Mouakad read a letter from a constituent asking for more security in the city’s schools and noting that the police issue seems to be the main focus of the Department of Racial and Social Justice, while other needs aren’t being given the attention they deserve. Councilor Burnley said that he looks forward to the more holistic discussion of caring for the city’s residents. Councilor Wilson commented that he reviewed past actions regarding filling police positions and said this essentially is an attempt to hire more officers than are funded. Councilor Pineda Neufeld moved to accept the committee report of April 6, 2022. Councilor Pineda Neufeld moved to sever items #213393, #213395 and #213396 from the committee report of April 7, 2022 and refer them back to the Committee on Confirmation of Appointments and Personnel Matters. The items were severed and the committee report was approved. Councilor Scott stated that it might not be advisable to refer those items back to committee and he would like to seek a legal opinion in an Executive Session at a future Council meeting.
