Councilor Ewen-Campen spoke favorably about her experience and said that it wouldn't be fair to judge her based on her employer's track record with unions. Councilor Clingan said he voted against her appointment in Committee because he doesn't believe human resources managers are friends to workers. President McLaughlin urged all Councilors to get involved in finding candidates if they aren't satisfied with the city's process. Councilor Scott supported Councilor Clingan's comments.
