#### **ELECTIONS REPORT ON WARD 3 PRECINCT 1 POLLING LOCATION CHANGE**

In accordance with Section 11 of Chapter 115 of the Acts of 2020, the Elections Commissioner of the city of Somerville respectfully requests that the location of the City's Ward 3 Precinct 1 Polling Place be relocated from the Central Library 79 Highland Avenue to the Properzi Manor 13-25 Warren Avenue.

On June 23, 2021 I surveyed the proposed site for the Ward 3 Precinct 1 polling place using the Secretary of the Commonwealth's regulations for polling place accessibility (950 CMR 51:00) and determined that the Properzi Manor at 13-25 Warren Avenue met the criteria for a polling place.

#### **FINDINGS:**

The Properzi Manor is in close proximity to the current location of the Central Library 79 Highland Avenue. It meets the requirements for site access, voting equipment, parking, entrance requirements and building interior. It is a Public building in the City of Somerville, is ADA compliant and will not have a disparate adverse impact on access to the polls on the basis of race, national origin, disability, income or age.

The Properzi Manor provides adequate space for Elections Officials to perform their duties while maintaining social distance from each other.

Based on information provided for you I hope you will find that this proposed change in polling locations is in accordance with Section 11 of Chapter 115 of the Acts of 2020 and will have no adverse impact on the voters in Ward 3 precinct 1.
